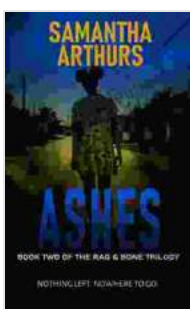


Ashes Rag Bone Samantha Arthurs: Haunting Art from the Depths of Tragedy

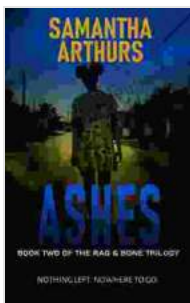
