## **Materials**

- Size 10 crochet thread
- Size 10 crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

## **Instructions**

1. Chain 4 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.
2. Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc 11 in ring, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
3. Round 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each dc around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
4. Round 3: Ch 3, \*dc 2, ch 1, dc 3\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.

5. Round 4: Ch 3, \*dc 3, ch 1, dc 4\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
6. Round 5: Ch 3, \*dc 4, ch 1, dc 5\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
7. Round 6: Ch 3, \*dc 5, ch 1, dc 6\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
8. Round 7: Ch 3, \*dc 6, ch 1, dc 7\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
9. Round 8: Ch 3, \*dc 7, ch 1, dc 8\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
10. Round 9: Ch 3, \*dc 8, ch 1, dc 9\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
11. Round 10: Ch 3, \*dc 9, ch 1, dc 10\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
12. Round 11: Ch 3, \*dc 10, ch 1, dc 11\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
13. Round 12: Ch 3, \*dc 11, ch 1, dc 12\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
14. Round 13: Ch 3, \*dc 12, ch 1, dc 13\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
15. Round 14: Ch 3, \*dc 13, ch 1, dc 14\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
16. Round 15: Ch 3, \*dc 14, ch 1, dc 15\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.

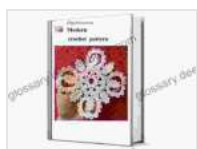
17. Round 16: Ch 3, \*dc 15, ch 1, dc 16\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
18. Round 17: Ch 3, \*dc 16, ch 1, dc 17\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
19. Round 18: Ch 3, \*dc 17, ch 1, dc 18\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
20. Round 19: Ch 3, \*dc 18, ch 1, dc 19\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
21. Round 20: Ch 3, \*dc 19, ch 1, dc 20\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
22. Round 21: Ch 3, \*dc 20, ch 1, dc 21\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
23. Round 22: Ch 3, \*dc 21, ch 1, dc 22\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
24. Round 23: Ch 3, \*dc 22, ch 1, dc 23\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
25. Round 24: Ch 3, \*dc 23, ch 1, dc 24\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
26. Round 25: Ch 3, \*dc 24, ch 1, dc 25\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
27. Round 26: Ch 3, \*dc 25, ch 1, dc 26\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
28. Round 27: Ch 3, \*dc 26, ch 1, dc 27\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.

29. Round 28: Ch 3, \*dc 27, ch 1, dc 28\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
30. Round 29: Ch 3, \*dc 28, ch 1, dc 29\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.
31. Round 30: Ch 3, \*dc 29, ch 1, dc 30\*, repeat \* around, join with a slip stitch to ch 3.

Finish off and weave in loose ends.
