looking for an adventure, I highly recommend taking a road trip from London to Sicily.



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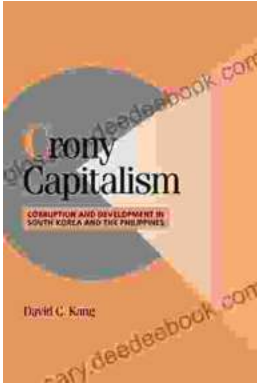
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
