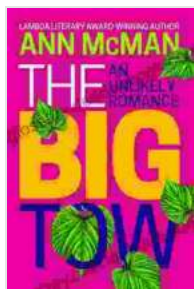


The Big Tow: An Unlikely Romance Consortium Sales

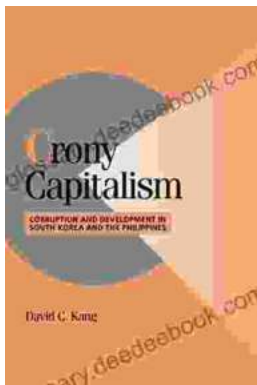
